Our dogs have been rehomed through our Home-to-Home scheme, from kennels at the Centre and foster homes.

Some of our animals have been rehomed via our "reverse matching" scheme that links animals with potential adopters already in our system. This reduces time in the adoption process which in turn reduces stress for the animal.




