






In order to make sure you are ready for compulsory cat microchipping, follow these steps:

- Make sure your cat is microchipped
- Create an account with the microchip company
- Once your account is created check your details are up to date
- Keep up to date if you move or change numbers

An email was received asking for help with a cat that had turned up at some holiday cottages a few months ago. He was friendly but no sign of an owner and the people who were kindly feeding him were concerned how he would fare over winter.

A member of the team went to collect the cat and took him straight for a vet check to make sure he was in good health and *luckily he was microchipped*.

After checking the details on the chip we discovered he was registered to an address in Manchester!

The phone call that followed was incredibly emotional. Mietek was an indoor cat who had disappeared over 3 months ago and his owners had begun to think the worst, having no idea how he had travelled over 120 miles to get to Wasdale.

His family arranged to come and collect him the next day and following the most beautiful reunion he was in his carrier and on his way back home.

If Mietek hadn't been chipped or if his owner hadn't kept their contact details up to to date, they likely would never have been reunited.

By the 24th June 2024 it will be mandatory to have your cat microchipped, as it already is for dogs and for good reason too.

Mietek has a happy ending, but there are so many out there that haven't been as lucky because they weren't chipped or the contact details were not correct.




